

CITY OF ROSLYN PLANNING AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES April 14, 2016 – 6:00 P.M.

Commissioner Sweet opened the meeting at 6:01 All Commissioners present except Commissioner Miltko Planner Graham was not present

Introduction

Councilman Cooke – introduced himself. He lives at 117th 5th Street alley His role is to serve as a liaison between the City Council and the Commission. His desire to improve communication. He encouraged Commissioner to please call him. His constraint is that he works evenings. Thursday is dance night at the Eagles and he has to be there at 6:40. He can skip two of them and commit two additional RHPPC nights. Will be here for about a half an hour and will come early. Jerry Johnsons (124 North 4th Street)

Commissioner Sweet asked if Would any of us benefit from this project -- no one

Top deck wants to put French doors

Make vertical windows like design of house....

Adding a second half bathroom – wants to add a small sky light in bathroom.

No roof pitch change.

We concurred that the changes Mr. Johnson is making improve the historical qualities of the house.

An added fence would match existing fence. He will take out a lattice fence..

Can he match the existing siding? He has some bits in the garage that he will try in mat
