## RESOLUTION NO 16-008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING AND AUTHORIZING 2016 STAND MANAGEMENT (B & C) PROJECT IN CONJUNCTION WITH AMERICAN FOREST MANAGEMENT.

- **WHEREAS,** the City of Roslyn owns approximately 300 acres of forested lands adjacent to the City that it manages; and
- WHEREAS, the City adopted a Land Stewardship Plan (LSP) for the forest and formed a Citizen Advisory Committee to make recommendations regarding the Roslyn Urban Forest; and
- WHEREAS, the City contacted American Forest Management (AFM) to consult thinning the Roslyn Urban Forest; and
- **WHEREAS**, the AFM and the Citizen Advisory Committee have developed a scope of work to "thin" sections of the City owned property.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City authorizes and supports Contractor Cody Pratt Enterprise, LLC in thinning Stands B & C of the Roslyn Urban Forest
- Section 2. In an effort to help ensure the protection of the Roslyn Urban Forest the Contrator will comply with all conditions in Forest Practice Application #2706107.
