A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING AND AUTHORIZING 2016-2017 SHADED FUEL REDUCTION (FIREWISE) PROJECT

- WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn has approximately 300 acres of forested lands adjacent to the City that it manages; and
- WHEREAS, the city is committed to protect private and City owned properties from the risk of wildfire; and
- WHEREAS, adopted a Land Stewardship Plan (LSP) for the forest and formed a Citizen Advisory Committee to make recommendations regarding the Roslyn Urban Forest; and
- WHEREAS, the LSP calls for hazardous fuels reduction; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Roslyn through DNR Firewise Grant was one of the first communities to do similar work in 2001 and 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The city supports the 2016-2017 "Firewise" project as authorized work to be done on city owned property.
- Section 2. The City authorizes and supports the Contractor ECODIG, LLC in Firewising the Roslyn Urban Forest.
