

RESOLUTION NO 11-027

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL HEARING EXAMINER SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH JOHN E. GALT

WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn is in need of hearing examiner services and desires to contract for professional hearing examiner services to include, hearings and rendering decisions in accordance with applicable state and local law and policy; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to provide a hearing examiner system for the conduct of certain quasi-judicial hearing within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has investigated the specific expertise of Galt and finds that he is, in fact, qualified to serve the City as hearing examiner and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN,
WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Roslyn hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with John E. Galt for Professional Hearing Examiner Services in an amount not to exceed \$110.00 per hour and \$200.00 for round trip travel expense


