

# RESOLUTION NO 15-011

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE 2016 REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Roslyn held a public hearing on the proposed 2016 property tax levy; and

WHEREAS, after considering all testimony and deliberations on the projected 2016 revenues and expenditures and tax levy, the City Council of the City of Roslyn has determined that the City requires the 1% Tax Levy increase, in order to sustain and improve the level of service provided to the citizens of the City of Roslyn; and

WHEREAS, Roslyn's levy from 2015<sup>20</sup> was \$193,477.33; and

WHEREAS, a 1% increase of \$1,934.77


WHEREAS, the City of Roslyn's population is under 10,000;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** A regular property tax is hereby levied for 2016 with a 1% increase, in the regular property tax levy from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenues resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any other increase in value of state assessed property.
