

**ORDINANCE NO 1195**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN,  
WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET  
AS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE 1187 TO  
REFLECT CHANGES IN REVENUES AND  
EXPENDITURES**

**WHEREAS**, the 2022 Budget was originally adopted on December 14, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the original budget was missing budget amount for multiple line items which resulted in an under adopted budget for several funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roslyn is committed to accurate and timely budgeting and reporting; and

**WHEREAS**, a budget amendment is required to correct the 2022 budget to more accurately reflect anticipated revenues and expenditures at the fund level;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSLYN, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The 2022 Budget is amended and adopted as follows:

<b>Fund #</b>	<b>Fund Description</b>	<b>Budget</b>
001	General	\$ 1,826,012.17
101	Street	\$ 405,770.34

**Section 2. Severability.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
